



Fundraising Ideas for Schools

This list shares some ideas for your school to do as fundraising activities linked to the "Become a Childhood Hero" appeal. For any event suggested or ones created by the school you could charge a gold coin donation or a nominated amount to participate. Money raised could be equally shared between the Australian Childhood Foundation and the School.

Childhood Hero Pins

Sell Childhood Hero pins for \$3 per pin or ten for \$27. (Pins can be viewed on the childhood.org.au website under Childhood Hero and can be ordered by calling 03 8870 2013 or order on-line).

Childhood Hero Capes

Sell Childhood Hero Capes for \$5 per cape. (Capes can be viewed on the childhood.org.au website under Childhood Hero and can be ordered by calling 03 8870 2013 or order on-line)

Cape Day

Why not hold a fancy dress 'cape day' at your school. Children can choose to wear any sort of cape – it could be a super hero cape or one they create themselves.

Sausage Sizzle/Barbecue

Set up a sausage sizzle for lunch. Parents might also like to get involved.

Spellathon

This would be a sponsored activity for kids of all ages to participate in.

Car Wash

Parents and teachers could bring their cars along to school to be washed.

Guessing Games

How many sweets in a jar? How much does something weigh? How tall is someone or something?

Crazy Hair Day

Encourage the children to go crazy with their hair for a day.

Themed Day

Choose a colour to be the theme for a day and the children can all come to school dressed in that colour. Classrooms could also be themed in the same colour.
